Jan Angel's opponent gets out-of-state funds in the millions — Illegally?

BELLEVUE, WA – On Oct. 23rd, the Washington State Republican Party (WSRP) filed a complaint with the Public Disclosure Committee for illegal contributions and urged that they file an immediate injunction to prevent Thomas Steyer's committee from spending that money in Washington State. San Francisco Billionaire Tom Steyer dumped \$3 million into the "NextGen Climate Action Committee" last Friday, October 18, 2013 blatantly and purposefully thwarting the state's 21-day prohibition of contributions above \$5,000.

WSRP Chair Susan Hutchison released the following statement:

"Senator Nathan Schlicher needs to answer this question: Will you repudiate this illegal spending by an outside donor or do you want the people of Pierce and Kitsap County to be represented by someone bought and paid for with illegal out of state money? Which is it? Today I call upon the PDC to do their job and protect the integrity of our election process by filing an injunction to stop Tom Steyer from using his illegally contributed money to attempt to buy the election for Senator Schlicher."

The WSRP calls on Nathan Schlicher to repudiate this illegal \$3,000,000 contribution made by his largest financial supporter. Does Nathan Schlicher want a citizen of San Francisco to choose the next senator from the 26th district using illegal campaign funds?

Mistake or Maneuver?

The House of Representatives – or at least a significant majority thereof – made every effort to eliminate Obamacare. Or at least *defund* it or *delay* it if they couldn't actually *derail* it.

Of course, the Democrats, aided and abetted by their allies in the media trumpeting their characteristic left-wing invective, demanded that a few “extremists” cease holding the president hostage for strictly partisan motives.

Really? A few extremists? There were an overwhelming number of house members – my count was 230 to 189 – that voted to fund all government activities except Obamacare. This significant majority of the House did its job. It read the bill, highlighted the flaws, and refused to fund it prior to enacting changes to reduce the damage that it would do to healthcare in general, to the economy, and to the public at large

Freedom Supporters named enemies of this Government Agency

The Freedom Foundation has been in the news lately for filing information requests with a handful of state agencies. You can read a few of these news articles at <http://myfreedomfoundation.com/blog/liberty-live/detail/are-state-agencies-targeting-conservatives-too>

The Puget Sound Partnership was one of these agencies. One of the ways Puget Sound Partnership spent your tax dollars last year was to hire a consultant group to create a 14-page "messaging document."

This outside consultant reviewed all the press releases and stories related to shoreline master plans (SMPs) in Washington State and had some interesting things to say about the "opposition." Apparently, according

to their 2012 messaging guide, if you support freedom and prosperity, then you are the "opposition."

This report was widely distributed among the Puget Sound Partnership staff. What stands out about this report to us is just how explicitly the authors admit that their "opposition" are those who support core values like freedom and prosperity. How terrible to support freedom and prosperity! The report is all about how to "reframe the discussion," not to "rebut the claims," to "use imagery" rather than facts, and other recommendations taken to heart by the Puget Sound Partnership and others who support the harmful, destructive policies that various state and local agencies have pushed on their communities.

If you ever wonder why the folks

pushing big government, hostile regulations, and harmful rules all sound the same, it is because they follow reports like this one, and they are mostly preaching from the same book. To ensure bias in this report, look on the last page for the "List of Interviewees." With only a couple of exceptions, most of these people are some of the strongest supporters of the total surveillance state, as well as government expansion - all in the name of the environment. For example, Stephanie Buffum is on this list. She trespasses on private property, takes her own photos of private property owners (unless they donate to her organization), and hounds code enforcement to ensure maximum, extreme penalties are inflicted on the targeted citizens.

Problems, problems, for Obamacare Website

The Obama administration announced on Oct. 25th that it was putting a private firm in charge of "fixing" its faulty health insurance website.

The project, which was overseen by the Obama administration, has had problems since it was released on Oct. 1st. Recently, the developer admitted the website hadn't been sufficiently tested before its release, and is full of "bugs", which is causing big problems. The Obamacare website – Healthcare.gov – set up for people to sign up for Obamacare in the 36 states which don't have state exchanges in place - still isn't working.

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), the federal agency within the Dept. of Health & Human Services, was in charge of the website, and didn't conduct the first "test" of the website until just two weeks before the roll-out. Usually, testing takes place months ahead of going "live" for a website, to allow time to work out problems. The new contractor – Quality Soft-

ware Services, Inc. (QSSI) has been given a deadline of Nov. 15th to get the problems resolved, and has received an \$85 million contract to work on HealthCare.gov, including building the online marketplace's "data hub", a complex network connecting the website with state, federal and insurance company databases. That company was bought by United-Health Group in Sept. 2012, raising a question about a possible conflict of interest.

(According to estimates reported in *The Washington Post*, the floor for spending on the Web site to date appears to be at least \$170 million, with an upward potential of nearly \$300 million.)

More than 100 problems still need to be resolved, according to an article in *The Washington Post*. Some of those include three out of 10 users are unable to complete the enrollment process, and error-riddled reports sent to insurance companies, making it difficult for the insurance companies to know who their customers are.

The online "marketplace" is supposed to send each insurer a daily report listing people who have just enrolled, but sometimes, the report is confusing and duplicative, according to insurance industry officials. Sometimes the family members aren't all accounted for in the reports, making it time-consuming and costly for the insurer to contact and correct the errors.

Meanwhile, Washington State's Exchange is also having problems, as the *Peninsula Daily News* reported that 8,000 recipients were given erroneous tax credits due to a glitch between it and the federal system.

Both Republicans and Democrats are on board about wanting an extension of the open enrollment period, which currently ends March 31.



Eminent Domain to be used to acquire property for city's enrichment?

The City of Seattle is seeking to condemn a parking lot owned by a 103-year-old woman through the power of eminent domain, who does not want to sell it, to build...nothing – at least for now. They want city-run parking at the location. Myrtle Woldson's property is worth \$5 million undeveloped, by appraisers say its developed value is around \$130 million, according to a KIRO news report.

William Maurer from the Washington chapter of the Institute for Justice, a great organization that stands up to protect citizens against questionable government takings, wrote in with his perspective (and to be clear, neither Maurer nor IJ represent the property owner in this case):

"The city needs to tread carefully in this area. A condemnation must be for a public use and it is not clear what the city's ultimate purpose here is. If it's to run a parking lot, a parking lot already exists on the property. The government should not exercise this destructive power because it thinks it has a better way to run an enterprise. We also have to be wary of that the city is not simply trying to use the threat of eminent domain to obtain the property on the cheap and then turn around and sell it to a developer when the tunnel is complete. The Washington Constitution doesn't allow the government to play real estate speculator." (excerpt from Rob McKenna article at *Smarter Government.org*.)

PAC, which is spending more than \$1 million against Jan Angel in the LD 26 special election in Port Orchard and Gig Harbor. In addition, Steyer's committee has dropped \$275,000 into the Washington Conservation Voters, which in turn has contributed \$150,000 to She's Changed PAC and \$55,000 to the Kennedy Fund - the soft-dollar committee of the Senate Democrats which has dropped another \$217,000 into She's Changed PAC. All told, Steyer's committee has funneled \$455,000 into She's Changed PAC and into attempting to buy this election for Senator Schlicher. Mr. Steyer is already the single biggest contributor to a legislative campaign in our state's history, and it's clear that he's not through spending his Wall Street money on this race.

Air Force Academy considers removing 'God' from oath

The Air Force Academy is considering dropping the phrase "so help me God" from its oath after atheist Mickey Weinstein and his Military Religious Freedom Foundation (MRFF) filed a complaint.

The Academy's oath is: "We will not lie, steal or cheat nor tolerate among us anyone who does. Furthermore, I resolve to do my duty and live honorably, so help me God."

In a meeting with American Family Association at the Pentagon last month, an Air Force spokesman said Weinstein has no influence and that it doesn't even reach his calls.

Ironically, this week, Academy Superintendent Lt. Gen. Michelle Johnson responded to Weinstein within 68 minutes of his email to the Academy. She told Weinstein she immediately had a poster that contained the oath removed from a prep school wall removed (at his request) and that the Academy would consider removing "so help me God" from its oath.

The Academy's Honor Review

Committee met this week to review the oath at Weinstein's demands, Public Affairs Director Maj. Brus Vidal said in an interview with The Air Force Times.

At present, the phrase "so help me God" remains as part of the oath. Vidal told the Air Force Times they could: 1) make no change 2) make the God part optional or 3) strike the entire oath.

HERE'S HOW YOU CAN TAKE ACTION:

Urge Air Force Academy Commandant Brig. Gen. Gregory J. Lengyel to preserve religious liberty by defending the oath and recommending the Academy keep the current language intact.

Gen. Lengyel's influence is a critical part of the decision on the future of the oath.

A good question for elected officials and Agency personnel

Recently, we had opportunity to ask the following question of several elected representatives and State agency officials: "Can you tell me what the Preamble and Article 1, Section 1 says in the Washington State Constitution?" Not one of them could quote it. Next time you're in a meeting where an onerous law or rule is being pushed forward, you might ask the same question.

The Washington State Preamble says: "We, the people of the State of Washington, grateful to the Supreme Ruler of the Universe for our liberties, do ordain this constitution."

Article I, Section I, states: " All political power is inherent in the people, and governments derive their just powers from the **consent of the governed**, and are established to **protect and maintain individual rights**."

Then, ask the question: "Which of my individual rights are you protecting with this law or rule?" Then watch for their reaction, which will be most revealing.


