SB 5198 Mobile home community sales

Requires landlords to provide three years notice for closure or conversion of a manufactured/mobile home community (MHC), with limited exceptions. Requires landlords to provide a written notice of opportunity to purchase when selling or leasing an MHC. Provides that if a landlord receives notice of intent to consider purchasing or leasing an MHC from a qualified tenant organization or other eligible organization, the landlord may not make a final unconditional acceptance of an offer to purchase or lease the MHC from a person or entity other than a qualified tenant organization or eligible organization for 12 months.
