## **Clallam County Republican Party Precinct Caucus**

## **Schedule of Activities**

The temporary chairman shall convene the **Pooled Caucus** soon after 10AM by:

- 1. Call to Order for all precincts
- 2. Pledge of allegiance for all precincts
- 3. Appointment of temporary pooled caucus secretary
- 4. Election of permanent pooled caucus chairman
- 5. Election of permanent pooled caucus secretary
- 6. Pooled caucus chairman explains the overall process
  - a. Define Pooled precinct caucus versus Individual precinct caucuses
  - b. Primary purpose is to elect delegates & alternates to the county convention who will then elect delegates for the state convention and the state convention will elect delegates to the national convention
  - c. An equal purpose is to begin the process of submitting to the CCRP Platform Committee platform amendments & resolutions. (Let us know if you want if volunteer to be on the committee)
    - Submissions can be offered today thru January 27<sup>th</sup>. Electronic documents are preferred. The county convention will approve or reject all submissions from the CCRP Platform Committee.
  - d. Discussion within the individual precinct caucuses helps you know who you are electing

## 7. Begin Individual Precinct Caucuses:

- a. If a precinct has a Precinct Committee Officer, PCO, and the PCO is present, the PCO will be the permanent precinct caucus chairman. If a precinct does not have a PCO or the PCO is absent, a precinct caucus participant will need to volunteer to be the temporary precinct caucus chairman. In either case, temporary or permanent, the precinct caucus chairman will direct precinct caucus participants to:
  - i. Call the precinct caucus to order
  - ii. Appointment of a temporary precinct caucus secretary
  - iii. Elect a permanent precinct caucus chairman, if necessary because of no PCO
  - iv. Election of permanent precinct caucus secretary
  - v. Complete the CCRP 2024 Precinct Caucus Questionnaire
  - vi. Complete the 2024 Non-Binding Presidential Straw Poll
  - vii. Nomination and election of delegate(s)
    - Nomination and balloting for delegates shall not commence earlier than 10:30AM nor later than 11:30AM. Balloting will continue until all allotted delegates & alternates are elected
  - viii. Nomination and election of alternate delegates (Alternates)
  - ix. Adjournment
